**RULES: (Special Stud Beef, Prime Beef and Dairy Cattle Regulations at end of schedule also apply)**

1. All cattle are eligible except those from restricted or quarantined herds
2. All cattle must comply with current NLIS regulations. Pittsworth Show Society Inc will read NLIS devices on Saturday 11 March 2017. Pittsworth Showgrounds PIC is: QEPW0235. An Owner waybill must accompany cattle.
3. The age of all cattle shall be actual age as at 1 March 2017.
4. All animals **MUST** be registered in a herd or calf register of the respective Breed Society, and **MUST** be the bona fide property of the exhibitor. Checks of Breed Society registers will be made if necessary.
5. All animals **MUST** have a brand, either tattoo or fire.
6. All animals, which, in the opinion of the stewards, are not in a fit state to be exhibited, may be rejected and debarred from competition. Such animals must be removed from the grounds as soon as the exhibitor is notified.
7. In the event of the Judge deciding that the exhibit in any class or championship is not worthy of the prizes, **NO** prizes shall be awarded.
8. Any disputes arising, must be in writing and handed to the Recording Stewards for assessment by the Cattle Committee, within 30 minutes of the dispute, accompanied by the fee of \$50.
9. No refunds given (exceptional circumstances considered within 7 days)
10. Dehorned cattle may compete in stud section if conditions are acceptable to their respective society.
11. Maximum age of calf to be shown as calf at foot to be 9 months. Calf at foot cannot be shown in separate class.
12. All Cattle over four (4) months must have appropriate nose grips and all bulls over 12 months must have a nose ring. All stock **MUST** be in the charge of exhibitor or representative at all times.
13. All exhibitors to have Public Liability Insurance and to have same endorsed for traveling to shows.
14. Any exhibitor/competitor intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showgrounds will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with residual current protection and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected by a licensed electrical contractor and currently tagged. The use of double adaptors is prohibited and all power boards must be tested and tagged. Clipping crates may only be placed on the grounds at the discretion of the Cattle Committee.
15. It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to ensure that the leaders of their stock in judging rings and parades are capable of exercising control over the animals in their care. Children under 12 years of age leading cattle in the Grand Parade to be accompanied by an adult over 18 years of age.
16. Exhibitors are invited to parade their cattle in the Grand Parade at 12.00 noon. All cattle are welcome. Dress code applies. Cattle may leave the show grounds after the completion of all judging (*approximately 3.00pm*).

**NOMINATIONS TAKEN ON DAY OF COMPETITION**  
**NOMINATIONS MUST BE IN PRIOR TO COMPETITION COMMENCEMENT**

**Age as of 1 May 2017** To be eligible to compete in State Final, Competitors must be over 15 & under 25 years of age on 1 May 2017.

Competitors may parade the animal of their choice and may lead a steer, heifer or bull under 20 months. Event judged on the ability of the competitor to handle, parade and present their particular beast for judging.

**Dress Standard:** School cattle Uniform, Dust Coats or Breed Society Uniform

Class 4004 15 years & under 25 years (This class only eligible for State Finals) – will be conducted first

Class 4005 13 years & under 15 years (This class not eligible for State Final)

Class 4006 12 years & under (This class not eligible for State Final)

**Section 4c - YOUNG JUDGES BEEF COMPETITION**

**CONDITIONS:**

1. Entries will be taken prior to 3.00pm on day of show.
2. Open to persons **under 25 years of age on 1st May 2017**, although only persons over 15 years of age are eligible for sub-Chamber competition.
3. No less than 4 animals of a prescribed breed & sex will be provided. Every effort will be made to use a different breed each year.
4. Each competitor will be provided with a card on which he or she will place the animals in their order of merit and give reasons for doing so. Upon completing the card, it will be handed to the Chief Steward for presentation to the judge, who may, if desired, question the competitor on any points in his judgment or any feature in connection with the cattle being judge.
5. The judge, in making the awards, shall take into consideration the correctness of placing the animals and reasons given. The Society will arrange for a competent person to demonstrate the points of the breed and explain their purpose in the general scheme of animal husbandry immediately after the cards are handed in.
