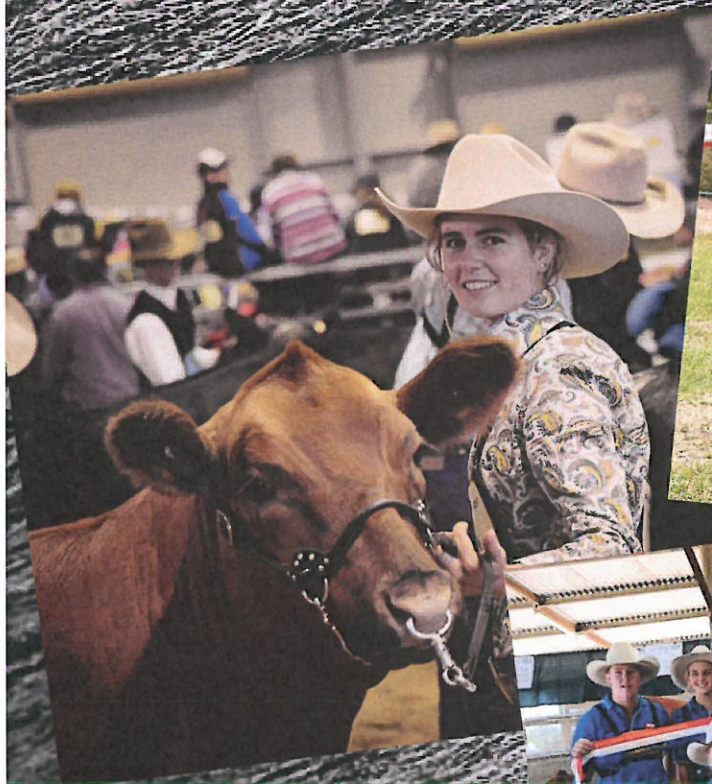

JUNIOR RED ANGUS

The Red Angus Society of Australia and the Junior Red Angus group has an exciting opportunity for junior members to develop their understanding of the beef industry while promoting the Red Angus breed.

The aim of the Junior Ambassador program is to allow young Red Angus enthusiasts to be presented with the opportunity to increase their involvement in the beef industry of Australia.

Up to two young people will be awarded an ambassador position which includes a scholarship to compete at a recognised junior event within Australia or to complete an industry relevant course.

All full and junior members of the Red Angus Society of Australia under 25 years of age are invited to apply for these awards. Applicants must be over 13 years of age to apply for a travel bursary. Junior members under the age of 13 and those who cannot travel will be catered for with exciting prizes to be won.



Entries will be judged on the following criteria:

- Involvement in the Red Angus breed
- Beef industry knowledge & involvement
- Future aspirations within the beef industry & Red Angus breed

Successful participants are required to

- Attend the 2017 Red Angus National Show & Sale & help out with the promotion of JRA.
- Select a mentor to work with throughout the year
- Attend a nominated junior show or industry event within Australia whereby Red Angus will be promoted

To enter juniors are asked to submit an application to the Red Angus Society with details on their ability to satisfy the judging criteria stated about. Submission of other achievements such as newspaper clippings, photographs or awards are encouraged.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The competition is limited to financial members of the Red Angus Society of Australia aged 25 years or under. Membership to be processed before the 1st March 2017.
2. Closing date of the competition will be the 4th June 2017 and NO LATE ENTRY will be accepted.
3. Applicants for interstate trip will need parental permission to travel to the event to compete if under 18 years of age.
4. The decision of the judging panel will be final and no correspondence will be entered into. The judging panel may award up to two scholarships to the event deemed most suitable for the entrant but reserves the right to only make one award or not to make an award.
5. The Red Angus Society of Australia may use any or all of the submitted entries for promotion purposes with the consent of the entrant.
6. Entrants must be over the age of 13 years as of the 1st January 2017 to qualify for the Interstate awards.
7. The Red Angus Society will subsidise travel costs to events however the winner may be required to contribute some travel expenses.
8. Personal spending money will be the contestant's own responsibility
9. Successful applicants will be supplied with a shirt and badge to be worn whilst representing the Red Angus breed. Additional clothing, if wanted, will be at the recipients cost.
